Layout Photography Competition for the Churchward Trophy

A layout photography competition to be judged at the Annual Convention and open to all BRMA members (whether they attend the Convention or not).

Information

- 1. Entry will be by means of the form on the previous page which must be emailed or posted to Rob Vernon at vernons@gate35.com or BRMA Photographic Exhibition, c/o Rob Vernon, PO Box 835, Belconnen, ACT 2616.
- 2. Entries must arrive no later than Friday, 13th September 2019.
- 3. One entry is allowed per BRMA member.
- 4. Each entry will ultimately consist of three 6" x 4" landscape format photographs of the member's layout or layouts, in a single frame. The layouts must be British outline. There are two framing options as noted in items 6, 7 and 8.
- 5. There will be no restrictions relating to the age of the photographs, the use of editing tools such as PhotoShop or who took or printed them.
- 6. The photographs can be either hand delivered to Rob Vernon at the convention or posted to him beforehand at the address above, in accordance with the instructions in the entry form.
- 7. If the photographs are pre-delivered to Rob Vernon, they should be sent unframed (but in a suitable protective envelope) and a frame will be organised for the photographs at the member's expense. Payment methods are listed on the entry form.
- 8. If hand delivered at the convention, entries must be mounted in a suitable 3-photograph photo frame. A list of suitable photograph frames is shown at item 14. The member's name and BRMA number must be written on the back of the frame
- 9. All entries received will be numbered and displayed at the convention.
- 10. Convention delegates will receive a voting form on which they enter the number of the entry they like the best. There will be no judging criteria. The delegates will vote according to their personal preferences.
- 11. The trophy winner will be the entry with the most votes. No other scores or rankings will be announced. The BRMA president, or in his absence the Vice President, will have a casting vote in the event of a tie.
- 12. Photographic entries that have previously won the competition cannot be re-entered.
- 13. Members entering the competition will retain the copyright of their photographs. They will also retain ownership of the photographs. Entrants not attending the convention must make their own arrangements to pick up their photographs.
- 14. Suitable photo frames:

K Mart – Frame Collage 8x16" Manhattan Black, 42-641-988. Cost \$8. This is the frame that will be used for posted entries

Other suitable frames might be found at Target or the Reject Shop, perhaps in oak rather than black.
