Friday, 22nd September

The Friday session of the Convention is in several parts. In the morning from 10:00am, AMRA Qld have invited BRMA to attend their operating session with the large layout in DCC mode. This is a great opportunity to review their extensive facilities.

In the afternoon starting at 1:30pm, there will be a Mini Expo in the Panorama Room at Pacific Hotel. Lunch is not provided but the hotel has a café and several others are nearby. Tea and Coffee will be served during the afternoon. The Mini Expo will be a display of model train goods and technical demonstrations by Scalescenes, Modratec, Aurora, MERG and many others. Also on display will be BRMA Qld's Modular Layout. Later that afternoon, the committee and area representative's meetings will be held nearby.

On Friday evening, there is the opportunity for an informal a la carte meal in the Hotel's restaurant Osteria on the ground floor.

Saturday, 23rd September

The Saturday program will follow the established format for BRMA Conventions, including a series of presentations, modelling and photographic

competitions, for the 2^{nd} time the locomotive haulage competition (Lunchtime highlight), display of other models, and second-hand sale. The presentation topics include:
