## Melbourne Convention – 5<sup>th</sup> October 2024

### Layout Photographic Competition for the Churchward Trophy



A layout photography competition with the winning photos selected by a popular vote by convention delegates at the BRMA Annual Convention and open to all BRMA members (whether they attend the Convention or not).

#### Information

1. Entry will be by means of the form below which should be emailed to: Manfred Ebinger: [BRMA-VIC@brma.org.au](mailto:BRMA-VIC@brma.org.au) or posted to: BRMA Photographic Competition, PO Box 404 Maryborough 3465, VIC
2. Photo competition Entry forms must arrive no later than 27<sup>th</sup> September 2024.
3. Only one entry is allowed per BRMA member.
4. Entries that have previously won the competition cannot be re-entered.
5. To allow entries to be viewed on a level playing field, each entry will ultimately consist of three 6" x 4" landscape format photos of the member's own layout or layouts, in a 3 photo frame.
6. The layouts must be British outline.
7. There will be no restrictions relating as to when the photographs were taken or the use of editing tools such as PhotoShop, providing that you did the editing. The photographs and printing must be your work.
8. Each entry must be mounted in a suitable frame as per the example to the right, which is a K Mart – "Eden Collage Frame 8in. x 16in". – Black, white or oak look, currently retailing for \$10.00, or a similar frame, if from another source.



9. The photographs can be either;

Hand delivered mounted in the frame to Manfred Ebinger at the convention with the member's name and BRMA number written on the back of the frame, or

If the photographs are posted to Manfred Ebinger, they should be sent unframed (but in a suitable protective envelope) and a frame will be organised for the photographs.

10. Convention delegates will receive a voting form on which they enter the number of the entry they like the best. There will be no judging criteria. The delegate will vote according to their personal preferences.

11. The trophy winner will be the entry with the most votes. No other scores or rankings will be announced. The BRMA President, or in his absence the Vice President, will have a casting vote in the event of a tie.

12. Members entering the competition will retain the copyright of their photographs. They will also retain ownership of the photographs. Hand delivered framed entries will be returned at the end of the day. If the entrant posted their photos, then their entries will be returned via the post minus the frame.
